

I'm a huge fan of Lisa Gardner's writing! One, she really puts in the research and then shares it with her readers. Not only do you get a great story but you also learn a few things. This particular story isn't as fast paced as some of her others and in that sense, some may have a hard time with the pacing. However, if you look at the scope of the story, the pacing makes sense.
