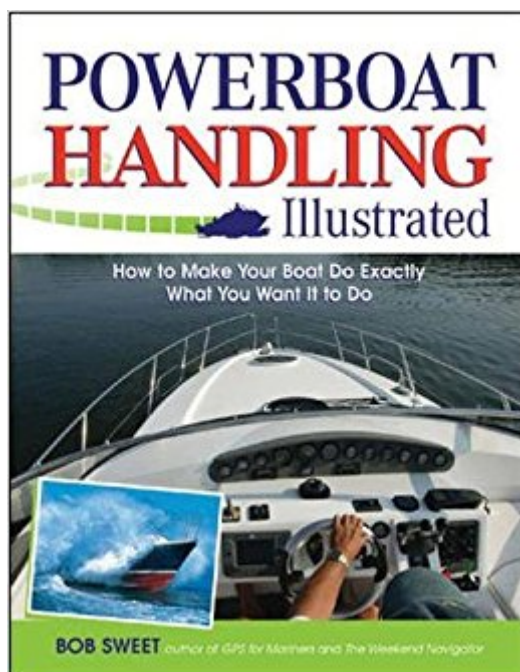

I bought the book after I returned the Kindle edition. I read a lot of technical books and the Kindle versions are incredibly frustrating because the illustrations do not work well. This particular book is almost entirely illustrations, so the Kindle version is a waste. Otherwise, this is an excellent primer on small boat handling.

This is a great book. It is short and concise enough to quickly reference. I pull it out all the time to take a refresh look at the diagrams. It's pretty basic stuff, but condensed and presented so you can absorb it quickly. Especially important for those of us who can't spend as much time on the water as we like, and don't want to look like a fool running into stuff.

I drove small powerboats on a small lake when I was younger. I am now on a large lake with a larger boat. I wanted to know more about boating and safety. This book covers all the basics. I also

completed a boating safety course, went out with a sea captain, and took a course on the waterway.
