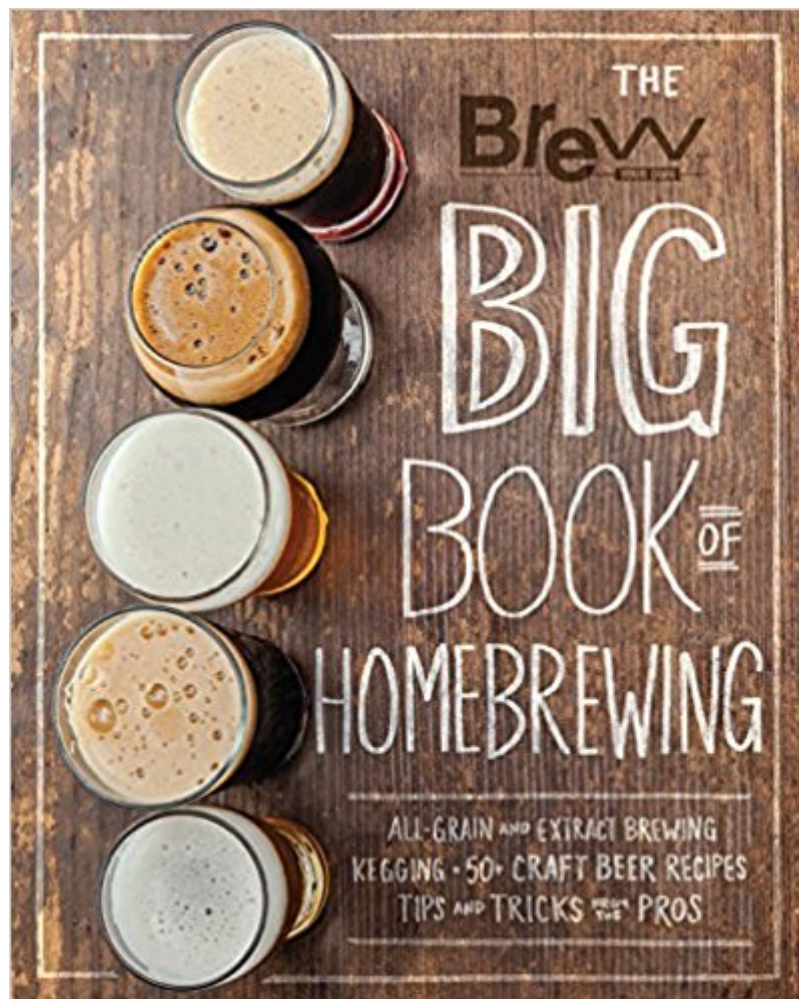

This book would get 5 stars but unfortunately the first beer recipe I went to use was incorrect. It said for 17.5lbs of grain to mash with 3.75 gallons of water and sparge with 2 quarts. Clearly not enough. Even as a beginning brewer I caught the mistake. Glad I did too otherwise my beer would have been trash. Thanks Big Book! Other than the recipes probably being wrong, the book does go into great detail about each aspect of brewing and how important they all are. It is a good book for the brewing knowledge. Not the recipes.

Finally received my copy, and love how this book is put together. Each page has clean uncluttered design, and the 50 recipes contained in this book are mind blowing.
