

Global Warming is Here

This book takes a complex topic and explains it using easy-to-read graphs and startling photos. I finished reading it on a 2.5 hour plane flight and I'm not a fast reader. Gore covers the science of why the planet is warming, why nearly all scientists have concluded it's human caused, and then the negative impacts to our health, to our air and

oceans, to our economy, and to other species. While a big critique of his 2006 book and movie “An Inconvenient Truth” were that the problems were painted big, but the solutions very small, this book is different. More than 50% of the pages are dedicated to the solutions and “what you can do” as an ordinary citizen. I particularly liked the sections of the book which give practical advice on “how to speak up about climate change at a town hall” or “how to write a good letter to the editor.” There are sections dedicated to getting politically active, with advice on how to start a petition and suggestions on how to call your elected officials (as well as why it is so important to do so). How do you talk to children about the climate crisis, and how can you change your career or change your diet to be part of the solution. There is also a link to download Gore’s new “Truth in 10” slideshow presentation, which features many of the key visuals used in the book and movie and he provides tips on how to effectively present these slides to your own audience at home. In conclusion, I felt much more hopeful and empowered by the time I put the book down. Instead of feeling depressed about global warming’s threat, I felt more reassured by the many actions and tactics outlined in the book that will empower us to press for more rapid change. If you’re interested in being part of the solution to the climate crisis, for less than \$20 and 2.5 hrs of reading, I highly recommend it.

Gore’s new book is a useful updating of his outstanding 2006 book, *An Inconvenient Truth*. It reinforces what we know from science about the grim reality of climate change and its concomitants, while refuting the nonsense spewed by President Trump and the rest of the climate change deniers. An easy read, it spells out with graphs and photos just what is happening to our one and only planet and provides a long useful guide to how we can and must work to head off planetary disaster. That said, the book must be criticized for failing to address human overpopulation, which is what is fueling climate change. It does not even mention the importance of halting the population explosion that can only render impossible the reigning in of climate change. There is no mention of the National Security Study Memorandum 200 report, “Implications of Worldwide Population Growth for US Security and Overseas Interests,” produced by the Republican Ford administration in 1975, which recommended universal access to contraception and noted the importance of safe, legal abortion. The Reagan, Bush I and II, and Trump administrations’ efforts to block access to contraception and

abortion have only made matters worse, along with Trump's pulling the US out of the Paris accord, his ending US support of the UN Population Fund, and his nutty climate change denial. Finally, Gore is remiss in not showing any interest in women's health, women's rights of conscience on reproductive matters, and religious liberty. -- Edd Doerr
