

Senior editor at Lucasfilm Ltd, J. W. RINZLER has overseen dozens of Star Wars books, including *Mythmaking: Behind the Scenes of Attack of the Clones*, *The Visual Dictionary: Attack of the Clones*, and *The Cinema of George Lucas*. Rinzler attended Parsons School of Design and New York University's Graduate School of Arts and Science. He settled for a while in Paris, where he taught art history and cinema for many years at private and public universities. As the associate producer for a video game developer, he wrote the scripts for a number of educational titles. Rinzler returned to the States to become managing editor of *GamePro* magazine, and published a number of articles on the industry. He is the author of *The Art of Star Wars Episode III Revenge of the Sith*. Rinzler lives in Petaluma, California.

This isn't like the books he wrote on the original trilogy. You get the sense that he wasn't as enthused by the subject matter. It is too much of a fluff piece. There are little snippets here and there that are interesting, things you can read between the lines or even just laid out for you about the making of revenge of the sith. It is evident that there was no script until much later in the game, Spielberg had more of a role in designing the action pieces that original thought, and a lot of money and time went into things that will never see the light of day. There wasn't that feeling of collaboration or excitement from the other books. Just a little stale and hollow. Even the interviews of this one were focused more on the work as a job rather than a passion project. The original trilogy books you could sense that there were a lot of people working on the project, a lot of love and dedication. This one was missing a lot of that. Didn't seem like he had the same access or as

thoroughly researched as the others. I don't blame him. Check out the original trilogy books, they are amazing.

The formatting isn't quite like the other making of books, which can be a bit jarring, but it's an otherwise interesting play by play of how Ep. III was made.

This is a really nice volume, unlike other making of books, you actually follow the production schedule, you see the last minute changes and so on. Obviously you also get a lot of photos, props, costumes and sets. Revenge of the Sith may have not been the incredible film that it could have been (but is not bad in any way, just lacks intensity and focus) but the behind the camera works was second to none, this book is the best evidence. If you love Star Wars, you should get it.

Great book

When this book was written, Star Wars Revenge of the Sith had not yet been released. So the "Final Chapter" was excluded from the book and made available later as a free pdf download. Unfortunately the official Star Wars outlets which hosted this pdf don't seem to have bothered to keep the file online. As such, if one purchases the book today it is thus incomplete! So BEWARE - it does not appear you can purchase the complete book any more. The "Final Chapter" of the book seems to be forever lost!

I've previously purchased this author's books on the making of the original Star Wars and The Empire Strikes Back. Like those two it's full of behind the scenes information, interviews and loads of pictures. For somebody that's a movie buff or a Star Wars fan this is a great book to have.
