

Instead, it should be "neat" as in "interesting" and "stimulating" and "elegant"

I bought this book in preparation for a three week trip to Japan this winter. Not quite a travel guide and not quite a history book, this is a nice introduction to three Japanese cities and the culture surrounding them. Told through a couple unique stories and biographies, it still includes the textbook guide book features with maps and location information. I really enjoyed reading this and it helped develop our itineraries for the trip. Nice illustrations to boot. If you are interested in Japanese culture, especially in preparing for a visit - I definitely recommend this book.

I really enjoyed this book, although it contained more history than I was expecting it to for a travel guide. It was more like a book on the history of certain locations in Japan, and then there was travel information thrown in at the end of the sections. I can understand why that would be frustrating if you were looking for a travel guide, but I quite enjoyed it and thought it was very interesting. From the writing (and the fact that the writer is from Japan), it is clear that the writer's first language isn't English. I love the fact that the book is written by someone from Japan because they are more likely to know the area better. However, the book definitely could have been edited better. There were a lot of parts where the wording was awkward or just not right. That's probably my biggest complaint with the book. Overall, I enjoyed it and thought that the information it contained was cool to learn.
