

What I like best about Mr. Perellos book here is that it echoes my own views and shooting style. That isn't to say that I didn't learn anything either from this book. I did. In fact, I learned a great deal. It is my hope to one day meet Mr. Perello in person and thank him for "bringing to light" about those who do chase the light.

"Chasing the Light" is about seeing the light and understanding that light illuminates and shadows define an image. It is well written by a photographer who is a real student of photography, a great teacher and someone who I enjoy listening to. I have been a fan of "The Candid Frame" since I listened to Ibarionex's interview with Vincent Versace several years. Ibarionex is the real deal. Along with Chris Orwig and Vincent Versace, I have learned more from Ibarionex than anyone else. I also saw Ibarionex in San Francisco at an Adobe event this summer. Even if you have been making pictures as long as I have (60 years), you will learn a lot from this books. Sit back and savor this book.

Very interesting read from one perspective of using available light to configure camera controls, composition, and taking pictures of almost anything anyone may come across in a normal day. The cover of the book is shot at a random street. This book taught me good pictures can be taken literally anywhere and one needs to be ready to have the camera controls ready at any given moment. Its a really interesting read and I read this book multiple times. As far as the photos and contents, I really learned a lot from the the technique he uses for his portrait and street shots. He explains the basics well from configuring ISO and looking for available light. Also he explains available light in different kinds of photography, some better than others. One thing this book has in its pictures that a lot of other photography books don't is the equipment he uses for each shot. A great read for anyone getting into photography or has some experience in it.

Less than five percent of amateur photographers read their camera owner's manual fully. But they all want to make really good photographs. They just don't understand the connection between the terminology of the manual and the process of photography. The connection is light! Once a camera owner starts to think in terms of light instead of photography, it all makes sense. Ibarionex Perello has done an outstanding job of explaining the use of light to produce photographs. He does it without complexity and without technical jargon. Now the manual makes sense. To get the best out of your camera, read the manual. To get the best out of your manual, learn about light. Read Chasing The Light. Then go back and read it again. Six stars!
