

I found this mini book about Benito Mussolini: A Life From Beginning to End to be informative and interesting. I will be honest I had minimal interest in Benito Mussolini before reading this book, but I

have read articles before about him while reading about the Italian war effort in World War II. Mussolini was an interesting character who at one time was a socialist and then became nationalist and fascist. I wish this book had said a little bit more about his family and how his son-in-law (who he had executed) was against Italy's relationship with Germany. I think this book is a good introduction to Benito Mussolini. Of course, anyone interested in this individual must research and find other articles and books if they want to know more about Benito Mussolini.

Where it not for a few typos and words that were inserted wrongly, I'd give this narrative pretty close to 5 stars! Historically, Mussolini was quite the buffoon but with a lack of humor. A terrible leader by most any standard, this short book calls the man out most accurately in its portrayal of him. Like most dictators in history, he was short in stature and believed himself more important than he actually was. In the end, however, the world can be thankful for this man's indecisive nature, but sadly the Italian people still cannot seem to find a decent leader to follow, even oh so many years later!

"Benito Mussolini" by Hourly History is a continuation of a number of brief historical stories of people and incidents. Even though somewhat abbreviated, it provides essential information on the subject for a clearer understanding. Though it may not be detailed enough for the serious scholar, it is clearly written for the average reader.

There were so many editing errors (omitted words, incorrect words and so many commas and periods out of place) I could not get past the third chapter. I will read about Mussolini elsewhere.
