

I purchased this for my granddaughter. The compact size makes it perfect for her purse, and she spends spare time reading it to increase her knowledge of Spanish. It is very user friendly, and is apparently effective. She has been speaking some Spanish for us, and yesterday was able to interpret the conversation of two strangers we encountered while shopping. Although she plans on taking Spanish courses, this book has really introduced her to more of the language than I had anticipated.

This pocket guide was wonderful for learning common phrases and communicating w/locals in Baja, Mexico. Very helpful! I learned so much from this guide just flipping through it before my vacation. Translations & phrasing are easy to understand & repeat. I gave it only 4 stars b/c I needed it to have a more comprehensive Spanish/English dictionary. It did not contain about half of the words I looked up (mainly from street signs, menus, and conversations).

Helpful when I traveled to Costa Rica and Panama. The size was also great. There were a few basic phrases that were not included which would have been nice. It was also difficult to try and ask someone a question because the book doesn't explain many possible responses, so you end up asking the right question but having no idea what their response is. I don't know that these problems are inherent to the book but probably to all books like this. At the end of the day, I ended up using

wifi and google translate a ton.

Visited a friend in Barcelona. Most folks there spoke to me in English (even before I said anything). Still, folks seemed to appreciate that I tried. Also, I was glad to have it with me.

Just got back from Spain - found this book very useful if I checked it ahead of going out to a restaurant or taking a train. The dictionary is a bit limited; I found I had to check online for most words I didn't understand.

This book is tiny and when I say tiny I mean like the size of your palm. I had to laugh because I thought I was getting an actual book. Oh well, it did have some useful information in it.

Very convenient! No need to go shopping! Five stars! Excellent!

None of the words we needed translated were in here when we were in Spain. It's also outdated.
