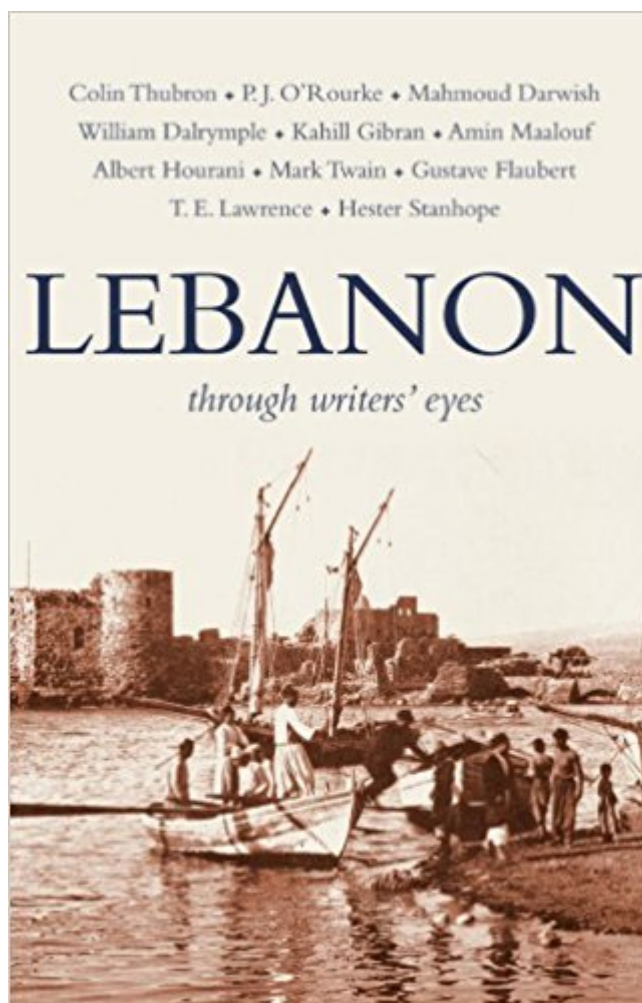




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Lebanon: Through Writers' Eyes (Through Writers' Eyes)

Ted Gorton came early to Oriental studies, spending formative years in Turkey where his father was the US military attache, and studying at the American University of Beirut in the 1960's.
