

George Lipsitz lived in St. Louis from 1963 to 1982, studying at Washington University and at the University of Missouri-St. Louis where he later taught. He is Professor of Ethnic Studies at the University of California, San Diego, and author of several books, including *Time Passages*; *Collective Memory and American Popular Culture* and *A Life in the Struggle*; Ivory Perry and the Culture of Opposition, which won the 1988 Anisfield-Wolf Prize as an outstanding book on race relations.
