

I would consider that to be it's only small fault but a really small one. I'm a map guy and sometimes I feel like you need maybe a little more description on what the place looks like. Does the towns and cities well and I guess since that's where they spend the majority of their time it's probably enough for now. I just let my imagination fill in when I thought it was needed. All that being said, I thoroughly enjoyed the book. Took me about maybe 4 hours or a little more to read it. Hard to put down once you get going. I'd definitely give it a read and I'll be hanging on to this one and eagerly awaiting more.

Very enjoyable dark fantasy book. I would describe it as a late medieval Vampire Earth combined with Blood Song. The coming of age portion was handled very well with nicely timed jumps forward in time. The world itself wasn't given great detail, but the day to day lives of the people living in the Nostros' land was nicely detailed. The bad guys in this book are indeed bad. There were many great action sequences and an awful lot of death and destruction throughout. My one minor complaint about the book: There were quite a few typo's and issues with grammar. This didn't detract from the story. But it could use an updated version to resolve these issues. Bottom line, if you like a good Dark Fantasy action novel then this is a great book. I highly recommend it.

Excellent book. Dark fantasy novels are difficult to do right, and I thought this novel succeeded in that regard. It is a Multiple point of view novel, but only focuses on two Main Characters. It Contains Fantasy and supernatural elements, but not much in the way of Magic. The progression from childhood to adulthood was done well, and I thought the Heroes and Villains were compelling and truly worth writing a story around. I hope the next novel is as compelling as this novel was.

I took a chance on this book, as a reviewer compared it to *Bloodsong*. I didn't see the similarity, but it was a nice read all the same. I liked the character development and really found myself invested in the story. I also thought it was smart that the author did not try to write in the POV of the enemy, as they are better left alien to the reader. I have a few little pet peeves, but nothing that took too much away from the story. As a military man, I found some of the tactical aspects to be a little too simplistic and I would expect monks dedicated to war to understand maneuver warfare.

Generally a novel with editing and grammatical issues will turn me off. Unfortunately, this book had quite a few. That said, it was a really enjoyable book with a fast paced story line, decent plot and nice character development. I would likely give this 4 or possibly even 5 stars if it had been a bit more polished. If you're ok with a typo here and there, this one is most definitely worth a read. I will absolutely pick up the next novel in the series.

However, when I find a book that I feel deserves to be recognized for its originality, story, etc., I will write a review. This book fits the bill.
