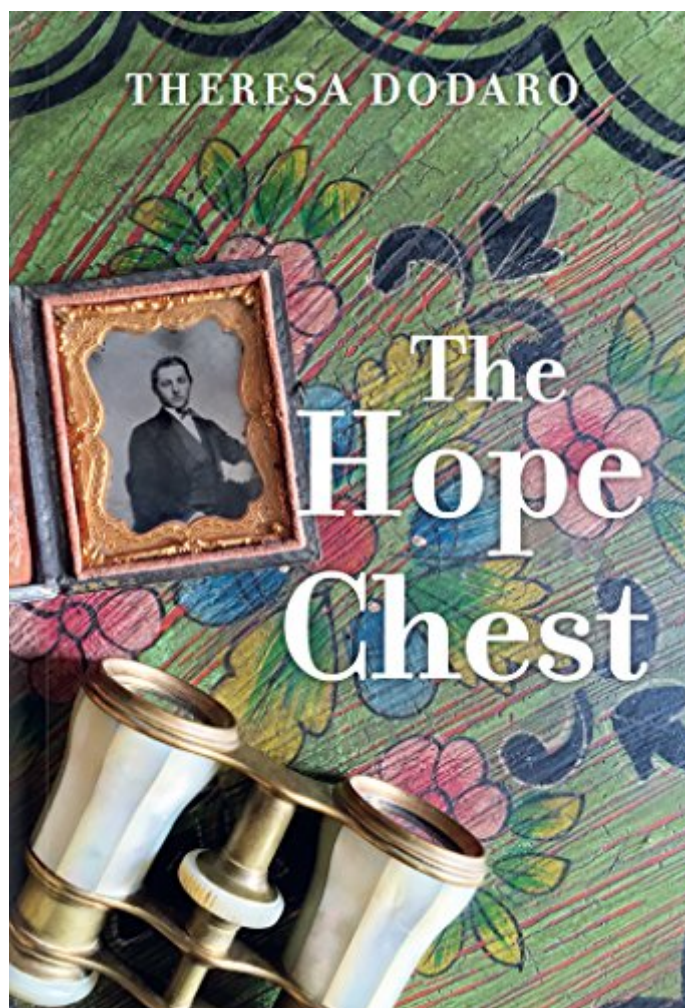

The second part of Theresa's trilogy "The Hope Chest" takes the reader back to the ending of the first book. Julie falls into a coma and relives her past life as Lottie Clark. We find Lottie in the middle of the Civil War. While I have read about the Civil War for various school projects Theresa's research showed a new part I had not heard of before. I did not realize that the town of Vicksburg survived in caves for the duration of the Vicksburg siege. This time period was stressful, full of death, disease, and starvation. In addition to this many people suffered horrific accidents if they dared to venture outside their cave. While Lottie is sick with a fever the readers learn of her time before the war started. We learn of two boys and how Lottie fell in love with one but was unable to contact him after the war. Theresa ends the novel by neatly tying up several questions I had at the end of "The Tin Box Secret". Theresa's second book is an enjoyable read with lots of action to keep the pages turning.

I think I liked this book better than the first only because I like reading about history.
