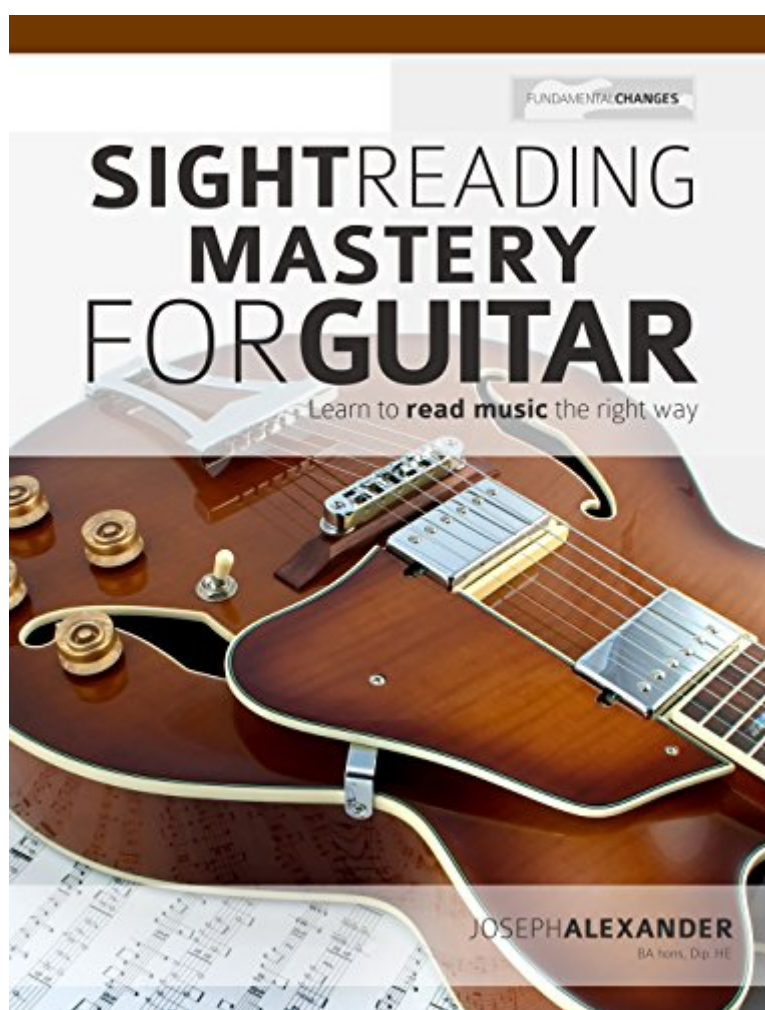

After more than more than 50 years of playing guitar by using my ear or tablature, I decided to move to reading standard notation. Alexander's book has given me a great start down that path. Neither old dogs nor men reach the stage where they can't learn a new trick or two. Thanks, Joseph!

Joseph Alexander is a master guitar teacher who presents his material the way guitarists think. Guitarists have unique fingering challenges that differ from the keyboard, and this book on reading music is designed for the guitarist. It starts with notes on single-strings, and progresses into the five basic fingering patterns (CAGED) with many practice patterns in both major and minor keys. This is a great place for guitarists to begin their music reading studies.

The idea for this entire series is brilliant. I only pay a small amount to learn what I am interested in at the moment. Same goes for Sight Reading Mastery for Guitar. If you can't sight read, start to learn how now. This book will open up a whole new world of music for you and enable you to have stress-free sessions with other talented musicians. Your choice is to poke along with tabs and chord sheets, and maybe learn how to play a few songs well, or...you can learn to read music and play them all well - right away. With this book you will learn where the notes are on the fretboard, and through these intelligent exercises, be able to translate from written music to where your fingers should be - without mystery.

Mr. Alexander understands the difficulties of making the transition from notes on a musical score to fingers on the fretboard. His challenge in this book is to provide the fundamentals in a visually effective way and then to offer extensive exercises for daily practice. He goes even further to introduce "rhythm reading" and "time signatures." In all, a comprehensive and impressive challenge for the relatively new but serious student of the guitar. And good preparation for actually playing music. Well done.

This is a great book for anyone who has always desired to play any note anywhere on the fretboard. It's great to memorize songs and it's great to know a bunch of hot licks. But this method gives a player the ability to pick up any sheet of music and start chopping away. I have found it very helpful. If you already have mastered the neck up to the 24th fret, don't worry. The rhythm exercises are worth the price of the book.

The author presents the concept of reading music in clear and concise manner in this book. The exercises are written so that the reader would have to read the notes; very good suggestion on how to practice. Overall, the book is very easy to follow; the author also included where to find new material to practice and the formula to improve in sight reading.
