

He really loved the different characters and their stories and can't get enough of the books. He's actually even reread them a few times.

The Mr. Terupt series was one of my 5th grade class' books for me to read to them. They were completely caught up by the real life description of each character. It's a good book to help teach life lessons to children as well.

This is an amazing book to share with 5th graders. I taught 5th grade for 5 years before switching to teach a lower grade. I used to start every year with the first book in this series. It hooks the students into reading at the beginning of the year. I taught at a school where kids HATED reading, and this

series from this author changed it for them. It's a story with 6 different characters. They are all in Mr. Terupt's class. Each chapter is a month where each student tells their point of view of the class's events. There is a character in this story that every child can identify with. It's "The Breakfast Club" for pre-teens. A lot of my students went on to read this book after I read the first one and wrote letters to try and get it made into a movie. Two thumbs up and a definite buy for me.
