

For all of you fishermen, divers, and underwater photographers in North Florida, this book shows you where to go, how to get there, and what you'll find at each location. Fishermen can plot the GPS coordinates given to seek out reefs that offer the particular types of fish they're after. Divers and photographers can use the GPS numbers to locate the type of marine environments that they want to explore and capture on film. This book provides about 200 pages of pictures and information about reefs located around Jacksonville and St. Augustine. For those enthusiasts who are new to

these sports, several of the reefs are relatively close to shore and in shallower water. For the more experienced sportsmen, pick a location farther offshore and make a day of it. Just remember to watch the weather and always play it safe. This book is well-written, logically laid out, and is loaded with great photographs taken by an experienced marine environmentalist. Keep a copy in your boat and/or dive bag. You'll be glad that you have it along as a reference manual. And pay particular attention to the sections that discuss the Lionfish, an invasive species that is taking over our reefs. Kill them and eat them. They're tasty little buggers.

This book is simply amazing! I would have never thought that I would have discovered a book that described what is found under the ocean. I am a underwater photographer and found this book to be a great asset to locating sites to shoot and fish. Great for the marine enthusiast! Thanks Joe Kistel for putting this together.
