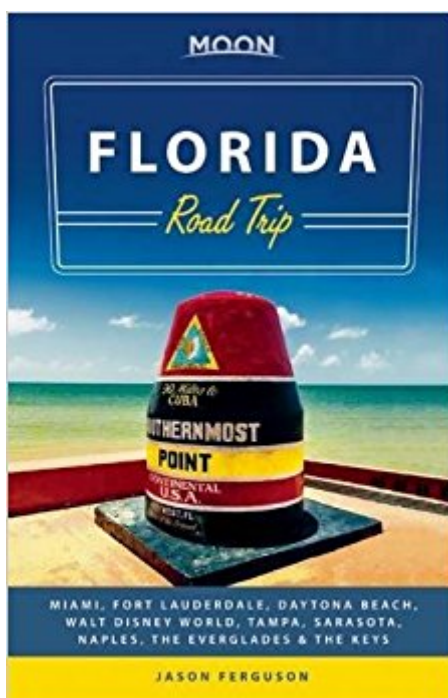

It's incredibly easy to step back in time in this part of the state. Here are some of the best places across the state to have a true Floridian experience:Fort Lauderdale Beachfront: These gorgeous and expansive beaches make up some of the largest and most beautiful municipal oceanfront in the state, with broad swaths of white sand merging into crystalline blue-green waters.Las Olas Boulevard: This strip of boutiques, galleries, and restaurants is classy and charming, evoking Fort Lauderdale's history.Worth Avenue: The 'Rodeo Drive of Florida' is home to stores like Cartier, Hermès, Ferragamo, and Louis Vuitton, along with pricey art galleries, custom boutiques, and ritzy restaurants.Morikami Museum & Japanese Gardens: For more than 30 years, the Morikami has been one of the most peaceful and beautiful destinations in South Florida, with a meditative museum and equally relaxing and well-curated gardens.Kennedy Space Center Visitor Complex: This facility's location within sight of NASA's launch pads and assembly buildings makes it a surprisingly evocative destination.Canaveral National Seashore: Bought by NASA to provide a security buffer for Kennedy Space Center, Canaveral has some of the state's most secluded and naturally beautiful coastline.St. Augustine's Old Town: Enjoy the beauty of St. Augustine's 400-year-old buildings and narrow walkways.When you reach Miami, don't miss these highlights around the city:Ocean Drive: This is the heart of South Beach, where art deco buildings house the hippest nightclubs. This part of town is as beautiful during the day as it is decadent at night.Design District: One of Miami's oldest neighborhoods is also one of Miami's premier spots for contemporary art and furnishings. This is a historic and artistic alternative to South Beach.Little Havana: Little Havana is the heart of the United States' Cuban American community.Vizcaya Museum & Gardens: The 34-room Gilded Age mansion and its 10 acres of botanical gardens have long been an icon of Miami's historical opulence.Coral Castle: This half-acre castle was crafted by hand from local materials as an homage to the builder's one true romance.
