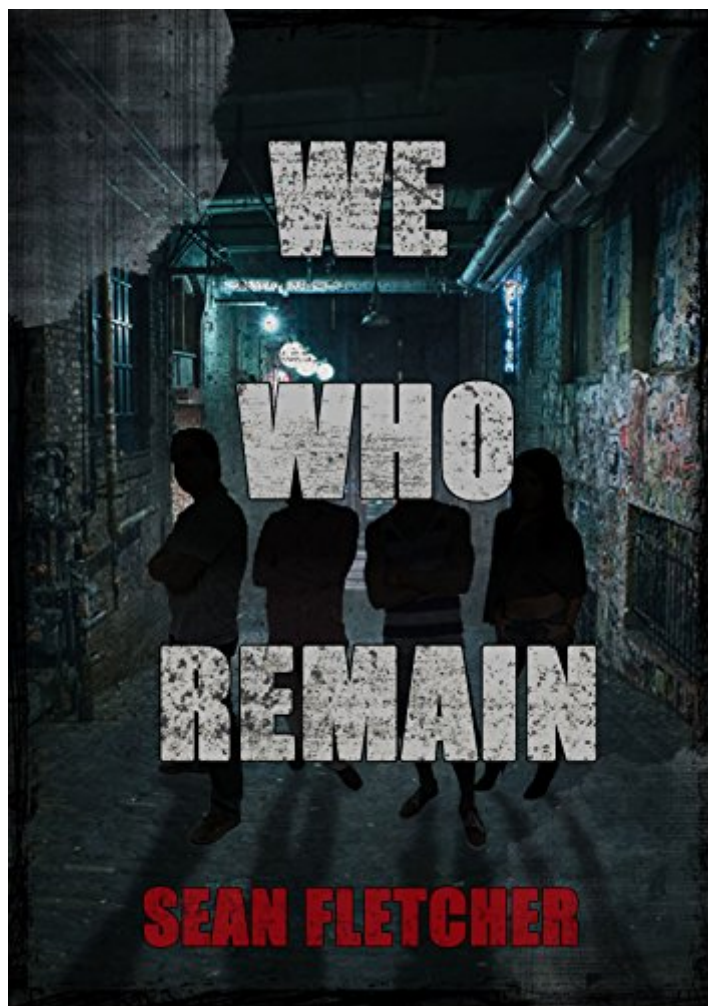


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We Who Remain (I Am Phantom Book 2)
