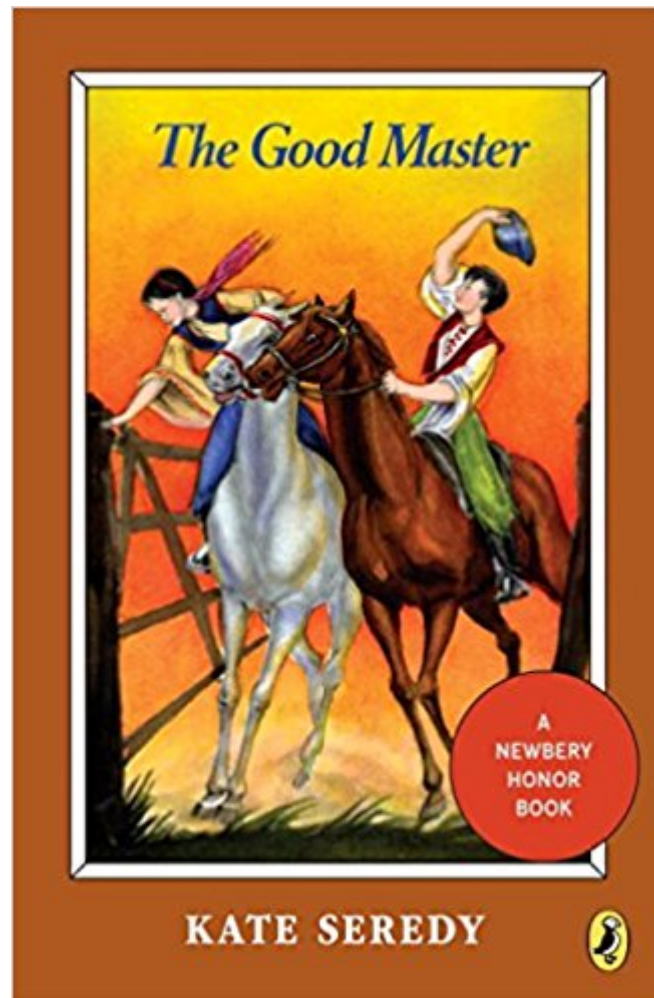

Simple story of country life about 100 years ago in a small farming and ranching village in a middle European country. It should hold the attention of a 3rd or 4th grade child. Good values in terms of family life, hard work in which every member of the family was expected to contribute, and great celebrations of holidays, village events, good times and bad times. "The Singing Tree" by the same author, Kate Seredy, is a sequel and equally worth reading. The two books are somewhat autobiographical, I believe.
