When I first started reading this book I felt that the author might have finally run out of imaginative storytelling on the Brides of the Kindred. She's written before about a female lead who's been raped in her past making her wary of any relationship with men meeting a Kindred who has to increasingly have sexual contact with her to help her in her particular situation, but doesn't think he is a worthy mate for this woman along with the usual corrupted High Priestess. (You wonder why the Goddess lets her High Priestess get away with the abuse she hands her Kallas for so long.) I was feeling that the series got stuck in a repetitive format with just the names changed, but I stuck with the book despite this and found myself getting involved with Emily and Tragar who was given a contract to kill her and discovered that the author still has what it takes to ultimately catch my interest about the Kindred and their brides in this ongoing series of books. This book isn't one of my favorites, but I won't be returning it and it sets up the next book "Forgotten" which I am really looking forward to as it sounds like a more original twist to the story that hasn't been written before.

I was hoping for a better finish after so many good stories in this series, but it seems the author should have ended the series about two books ago with a stronger plot. This has a couple of twists, but they don't really save this book for me. I found the love scenes fairly predictable based on the earlier books in the series. I saw reviews saying that this book was a decline from the earlier ones, but I've always liked to finish any series. Even if you are like me in that regard, you might regret spending even a few dollars for this finish. The last few books seem like they spend too much time trying to set up side characters for another book.

I adore this series and have been reading them from the beginning. The different kinds of kindred are fascinating. This one was a little different there were parts I liked a lot and I did like the hero and heroine; however, some of the scenes felt like I was in a Monty Python novel. I felt like I should read "yes, yes the spanking" if you've seen the holy grail you will get my reference. The dialogue and interaction during their trip to their home world was distracting to say the least. I just couldn't believe

how he had to help her during her transition. I really believe in the "suspension of disbelief" necessary to enjoy such stories but found that I was unable to do that with this story. I think once I realized why (ref. Monty Python again) I was able to finish to the HEA. I'm already reading the next one forgotten and already enjoying it even if it's kinda sad at beginning. I'm only part way in and look forward to their HEA. Overall I can't really recommend this one but maybe you will have a different experience reading it. There are nice tidbits about other characters especially the scene with Trin and Thrace which I loved. That scene felt like a true HEA for them. So for the update of others it was great and for the final realization of who Emily is and why she is important I say give it a chance... I know that may confuse some but I wanted recommendation to be well rounded. I hope it helps.

As with her previous books in the series Evangeline continues to bring to people from so far apart and have them find love in the end. When there is doubt or a need for the female to see that she really does love her chosen lover, especially like how the mother of all life speaks to her. Can't wait to get to the next one.

Emily and Tragar experience many problems, both together and separately. The story line of the Kindred seems to be expanding and evolving. I did find it tiresome how frequently Tragar had to meet the 'needs' of Emily, usually with the same dialogue each time. All told, a good story and I look forward to the next book.

As always, Evangeline Anderson can be counted on to write a wonderful and entertaining (and hot) sci-fy romance at a reasonable price. I am never disappointed when I buy one of her books. Her world building is seamless and she really makes you care about the characters. I don't want to give anything away but I found myself wondering if I had somehow missed a book for a couple secondary characters- Rone and Kate. They will be the couple in the next book in the Kindred series. I can't wait! I love how these books are not cliffhangers but together weave an even deeper story and adventure. On a side note, I really recommend reading the novella Mastering the Mistress. It was originally only available through Mastered 2 boxed set that is no longer available but the author is now making the novella available by itself. Mastering the Mistress is the story of Solar (first mate to the main character of Kindred 14). While it is not necessary to read before book 15, there is a very brief part where Solar is in this book. If you are a stickler for reading books in order you will want to get this novella before book 15.

This series just keeps getting better and better. I have come late to this party and it has taken me awhile to get through all 15 books, but every book is a new adventure. I love how the Author brings her characters from other books into the new ones - like check on your friends that you haven't heard from in awhile. This series keeps you eagerly waiting on the next book to see the next turn of events. The newest evil "X" is greatly done and I love the bit of humor you feel about this character.

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
