

Esposito's book is fine, if you're a theist and wanting to read about the successes and failures of a religion. Most all theists should find it well balanced---but again, that's if it's read from a theist's point of view. A non-theist will find it often frustrating and aggravating. For nonbelievers, Esposito's book tends to be one long weak apology. And that's a shame, because there is so much good information in it. The Q&A format is effective, but the answers to the dicey questions tend to be preceded by qualifiers (e.g., a question might be posed asking if Islam is a violent religion, and the response might read: the Christians and Jews have violent fundamentalists, so it's not unusual to find violent Muslim fundamentalists). Well guess what, maybe the Christians, Jews and Muslims are ALL wrong about their blood-curdling holy books??? Because one group believes in nonsense doesn't give others a license to act irrational and irresponsible. Perhaps they are are "touched." Many of the answers/explanations sounded like weak excuses---but that's what religions offer, excuses. Again,

nontheists will likely be frustrated. Esposito tends toward apologetics more than I cared to read.
