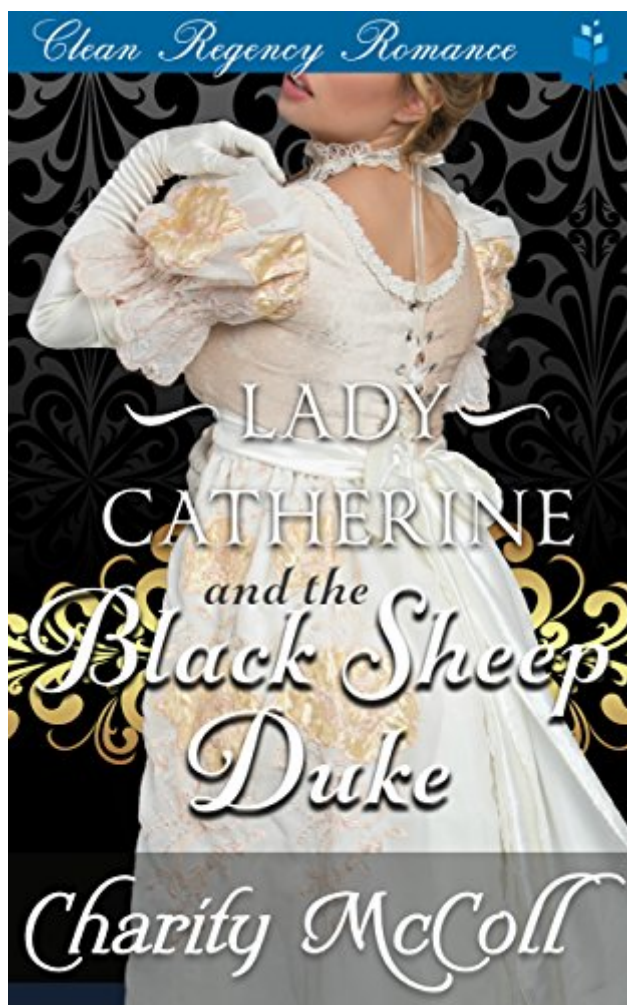

This murder mystery and romance is a good short who dun it. However, it is not as good as a Agatha Christie book for murder mystery or romance.

Silly shallow plot, thank goodness it was a very short book. I almost quite reading it several times but kept hoping it would develop into something interesting and then it was over.

Five sisters, ranging from fifteen to twentyone, are left out in the cold when a cousin inherits. Providentially, Catherine, the eldest, finds a job as a governess. And her employer, a Duke, seems to be the nicest man in the world. He allows her sisters to live rent free in a cottage on the estate and also allows them access to the main house library and music room. He seems too good and kind to be true. And he is - too good to be true, that is. Catherine confronts him and is heard threatening him. Then he turns up dead....A good mystery with a sweet love story, this book meets my expectations.
