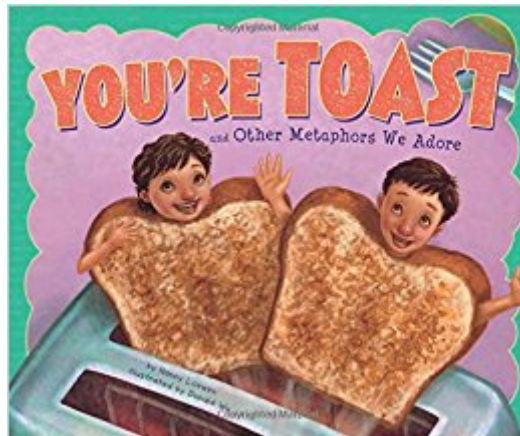

The author does not know the difference among figurative language herself. Shame on the editor and publisher. should not carry this book!!!!

Pretty much all of the metaphors are also idioms which made them more difficult for my students to understand when they had to write metaphors.

This was a great way to introduce my students to figurative language. It gave them great visuals and they were able to come up with some funny ones themselves. Great teaching tool!
