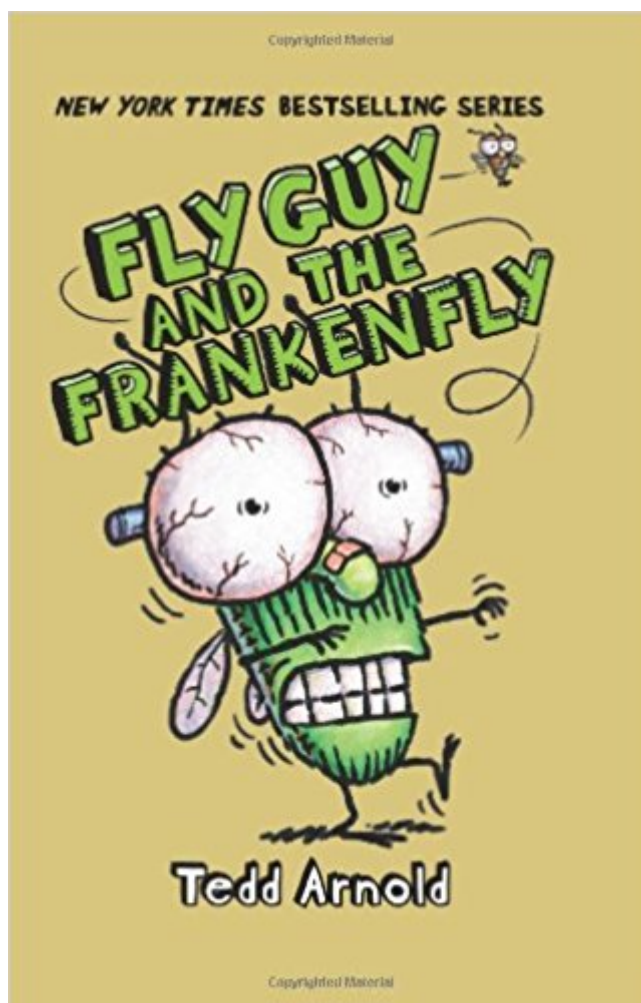

And Buzz is left with a charming sentiment about friendship. I always love the way the author translates plain English words into buzzy fly-words. Kids love to read these funny words and put great expression into them. The boys in our family (ages five and eight) are always delighted when I buy a new Fly Guy book. This is a good one.

My 2 daughters are in love with this book. I read it to my nephews and they also keep asking me to re-read it. Both my 4 & 5 year olds can read it to me now. They heard it a few times and were able to make great guesses from the pictures and the humor in the book. This book is funny. The vocabulary is just right for kids capable of mastering a few sight words and sounding out the others. Most of the words flow so kids can guess huge words too. I was AMAZED at what my kids were reading in this book, because it is so engaging they make the guesses instead of reading like a robot.
