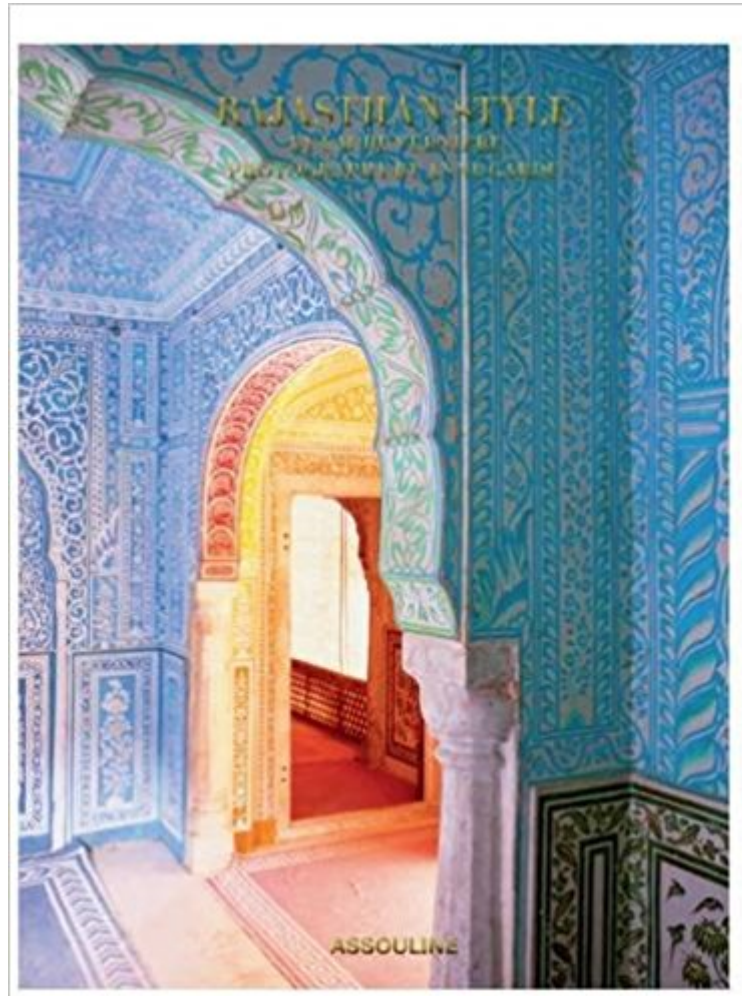

Garde's literary collaborator, Vernier writes the texts for Garde's photographic works. Together they have produced two previous travel journals: Japan Express (Le Seuil, 2003) and Pondicherry Masala (Le Seuil-Le Thémis des écrivains, 2004). Vernier also creates multimedia artworks combining Polaroids, visual poems, collages, repurposed objects, and paintings, which she exhibits in France and abroad.
