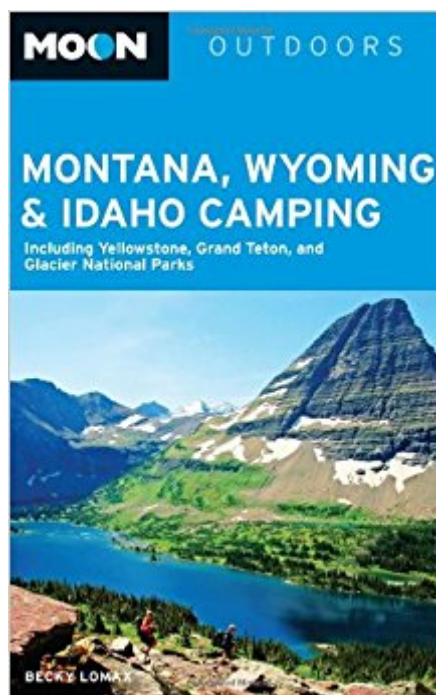

Becky Lomax grew up camping. She cherishes fond memories of family camping trips in a yellow station wagon packed door-to-door with five raucous kids and their gear. Piled on air mattresses or cots in a canvas tent, she and her siblings woke each morning to their mom doling canned grapefruit and mandarin oranges into plastic camping bowls while their dad pumped the green two-burner Coleman stove to cook pancakes. Like any camping family, they had their share of rain, mosquitoes, vehicle breakdowns, and siblings who strip-mined the chocolate from the gorp bag. Her brothers still swear they didn't put that frog in her sleeping bag; but she's not convinced. Today, Becky's favorite kind of travel still involves backpacking, hiking, and camping; especially with her nieces and nephews. After 10 years as a hiking and backpacking

guide in Glacier National Park, she now travels the Northern Rockies as a full-time professional outdoors writer and photographer. She uses her writing career as an excuse to camp, hike, mountain bike, kayak, and ski. Her favorite research involves wildlife: She has followed biologists into the field to band raptors and radio-collar bighorn sheep and grizzly bears. Becky is also the author of Moon Glacier National Park, and her work has been published in various magazines, including Smithsonian, Backpacker, National Wildlife, Cross Country Skier, Montana Magazine, Montana Outdoors, and Northwest Travel. --This text refers to an alternate Paperback edition.

It is deceptive to have the title as "Montana, Idaho and Wyoming." This book only covers the western part of Montana, northern Idaho and western Wyoming.

This is a great guide for camping in our area. Although it doesn't list all of the campgrounds, the explanations are very clear for the ones that are listed and it has been very helpful when we go to an area we are not familiar with. We keep it on hand first in the house, and then in the camper as we plan weekend trips. I liked it so well I purchased a second one as a gift for friends.

I've used Moon guides to CA and Pacific Northwest. Those are excellent and thorough guides to camping in the West. Becky's guide does not include any campgrounds south of I-84 or along the highway 95 corridor in Idaho. Also, the information on some of the campgrounds that we have stayed in and that are included in the guide are inaccurate .. number of sites or their quality. Of course, things change .. but, a guide book author should be responsible for keeping them more accurate and include better coverage. I have not used the guide in Montana or Wyoming .. perhaps that where it's forte resides. If I had seen the limited coverage map at the beginning of the book, I would not have purchased it.

Just OK. Little real opinion given on campgrounds. We are tent campers and the campgrounds they recommended around Stanley, Idaho were crowded and near roads.

We used this book for our summer trip to Yellowstone and Utah. There were many Idaho and Western Montana campgrounds not listed. It is really only for planning a trip to and around Yellowstone.

Does not cover all of Idaho! Useless if you are in the area of Idaho not covered by this "travel" guide.
