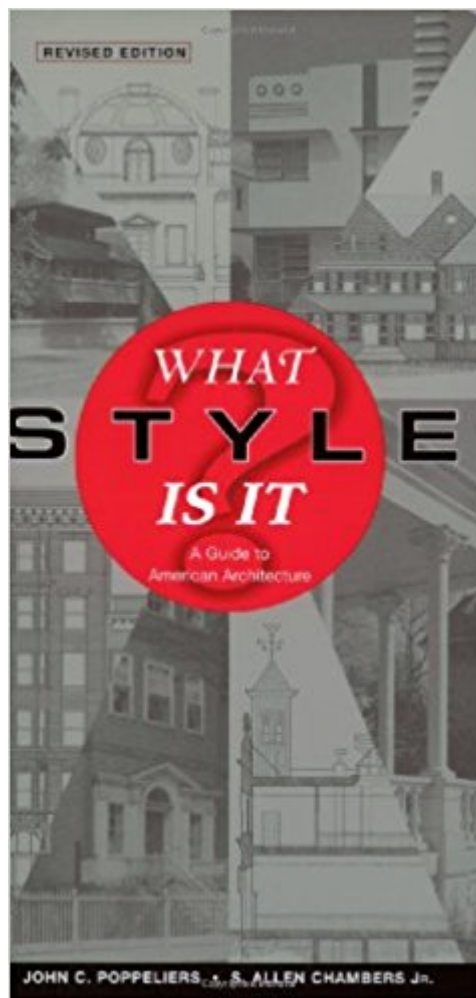




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What Style Is It?: A Guide To American Architecture, Revised Edition
