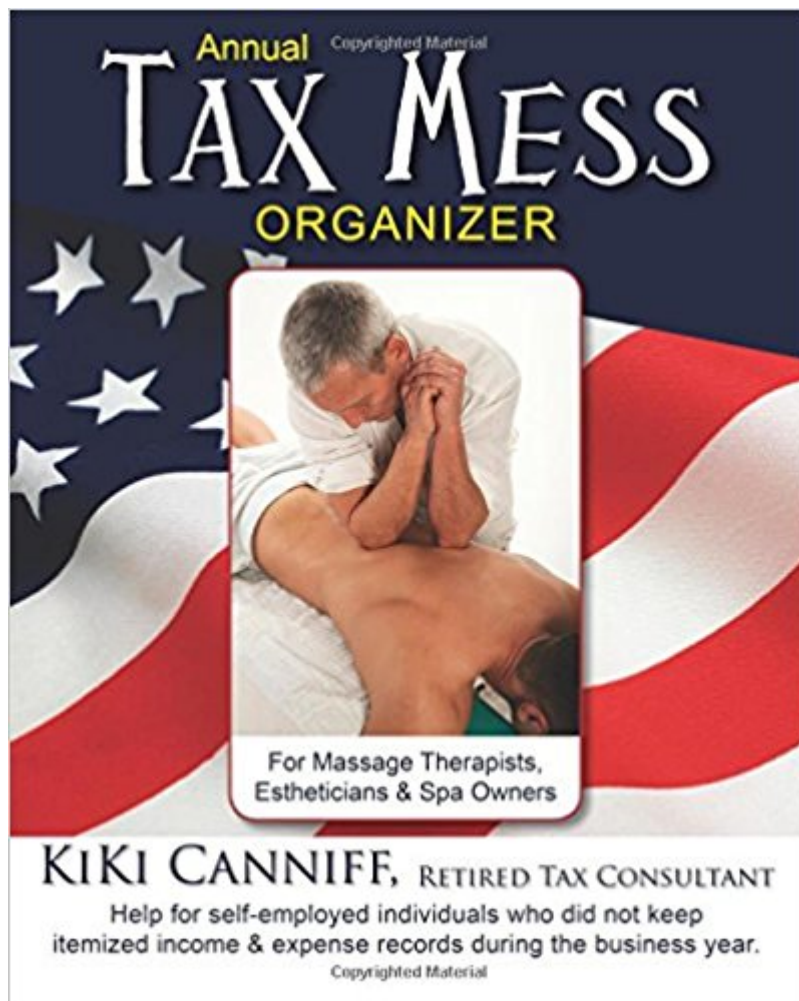

Self employment taxes, 1040 entries, and other deductions available to the independent contractor are also explained.
