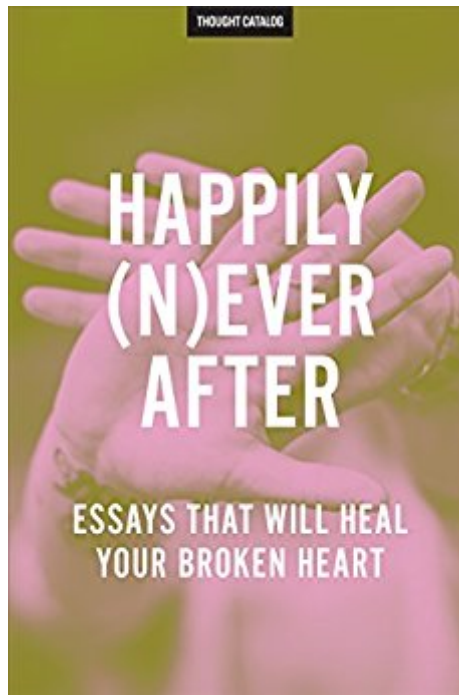




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# Happily (N)ever After: Essays That Will Heal Your Broken Heart
