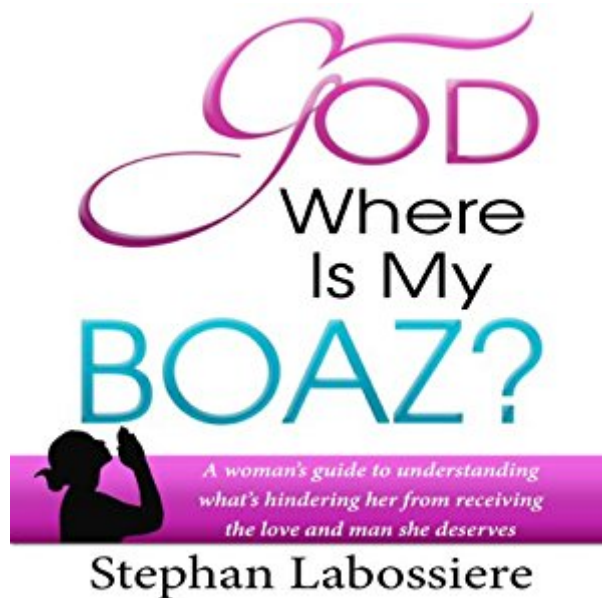

For example, in the one chapter Stephan says one problem might be that you have religion but you don't have a relationship with God. I would recommend this book to any single woman.
